Attire: Please wear clothing that you would wear for your clinical rotations at school. You should also bring scrubs in case you will be in surgery or in the ER, as well as your lab coat, stethoscope, and any other tools you need for a successful day in the clinic.

Schedule: Most externships are scheduled from Monday to Friday unless other arrangements have been made.

The hospital has morning rounds daily beginning at 8 am except for Tuesdays. On Tuesday mornings, we have three hours of didactic teaching beginning at 7am. These typically consist of an intern lecture, morning rounds, and another formal rounds session such as morbidity and mortality rounds, radiology rounds, or journal club. Please plan to arrive 10 minutes prior to the start of morning rounds.

On your first day, introduce yourself at the front desk and someone will direct you to the conference room for rounds. We will give you a tour of the hospital after rounds. We will also take a photo of you during your stay so we can put names with faces when we are selecting interns for the following year.

If you are receiving credit for your externship, you should plan to spend a minimum of five days at the hospital. If you would like to spend time here on the weekend or come in for a later shift to get a sense of what nights and weekends are like at the hospital, just let us know and we can accommodate you.

Parking: Employee and visitor parking is available in our parking lot on the east side of the building or along the outside of the parking lot on the north and west sides. Please leave spaces closest to the main entrance for clients.

Food: There are many local restaurants within driving distance of the practice. You can also bring your own meals; the staff break room has a refrigerator you can use. We also have a fresh food market where food can be purchased in hospital.

Lodging: There are several hotels near the hospital (see list below), short term rentals through VRBO or Airbnb may also be an option for you.
